- A behaviour based safety approach focuses on The What and Why of people's actions
- We focus on the positive, communication, feedback, engagement & 360° involvement.

HABIT

We all should:

- Challenge bad habits
- Praise good habits.



LEAD BY EXAMPLE

- We are all leaders
- Set good examples for all
- Positive examples are the most influential
- Live by good values
- Help others to do this for themselves.



TIME VS RISK

- Do not compromise Safety to save time
- Plan work with enough time
- Use of correct equipment reduces temptation to take shortcuts
- Rules & procedures need to be fit for purpose.

ALPHA STATE

Alpha state is when the subconscious mind takes over:

- Good habits & subconscious routines keep us safe
- Look out for your teammates when in alpha state.

WALK OVER

- Don't Walk by
- Address issues face to face at the time in a positive way
- Set high standards to be followed
- Being proactive may prevent injury
- **Report close calls!!!**

WORKSAFE PROCEDURE

Fuse Rail believe if the work can not be done safely – it should not be done.

Safety is everyone's responsibility!

If safety is compromised;

1. Cease work immediately
2. Move to a position of safety
3. Contact person in charge and explain.

All concerns raised will be given serious consideration without recrimination.



If you feel any of the above is lacking, **Challenge it!**
